



2016-17 Presidential Citation for Rotaract Clubs

Your Rotaract club works hard to serve humanity. Help members feel proud of their accomplishments by earning a Presidential Citation for your club. To qualify for the 2016-17 Presidential Citation, Rotaract clubs must complete two mandatory activities and at least three additional activities between 1 July 2016 and 30 June 2017.

Since your club's accomplishments will be automatically verified based the data you provide on Rotary.org, there are no forms or reports to submit. Please note that Rotary is unable to grant exceptions to the deadline or to the online reporting requirement.

Rotaract club presidents, work with your sponsor Rotary club leaders to track your progress toward each of the citation's goals on Rotary.org and to verify accuracy. Should you find any discrepancies, please report them to rotaract@rotary.org in advance of the **30 June deadline**.

Your district governor can also review the progress of all Rotaract clubs in your district on Rotary.org.

Mandatory activities (complete both)

- Report yourself as Rotaract club president or report your adviser on Rotary.org.
- Update and confirm your club's member data through the Club Administration page on Rotary.org.

Additional activities (complete at least three)

- Add or update your club's contact, meeting details, and connections preferences through the Club Administration page on Rotary.org.
- Have at least 15 club members reported on Rotary.org. Members can register themselves by creating an account, or the Rotaract club president can report them.
- Have at least 50 percent of members identify their skills and interests in their My Rotary profiles and unlock that section to display on public profiles.
- Post at least one completed service initiative on [Rotary Showcase](#).
- Post a project in need of assistance on [Rotary Ideas](#) **or** contribute to a project there.
- Have the club or any of its reported members contribute (any amount) to either Rotary's Annual Fund or PolioPlus in honor of The Rotary Foundation centennial.
- Add or update your club's website or social media page through the Club Administration page on Rotary.org. Use Rotary's [Brand Center](#) templates and [Visual Identity Guidelines: Rotary's Programs for Young Leaders](#) to update your club's logo and imagery.
