Project Name: Five Ringgit Campaign For Typhoon Disaster Victim

Objectives:

- To supply sufficient supply to the victims

- To look into the possibility of raising funds in long term in an effort to assist in the restructuring and rebuilding of public needs.
- Created public awareness on the existence of Rotary Club and Rotaract Club.
- Strengthened International ties between RI District 3300 and RI District 3820.

Campaign Period: 1st February 2010 – 15th April 2010

Budgets and Expenses: Disaster Fund Collection Cards and Postcards printing are sponsors by Ricoh (M) Sdn Bhd.

Introduction:

The “ Five Ringgit Campaing” is organized by Rotaract Club Of Pudu partnered with Rotaract Club of San Pedro District 3820 and supported by Rotary Club of Pudu. The fund that we collected will directly channel to Rotaract Club of San Pedro.

Rotaract Club of San Pedro was chartered in year1986, has 24 years history in district 3820. We have get in touch with each other since RY06/07 through 4th Asia Pacific Regional Rotaract Conference in Malaysia. In RY07/08, we, Rac Pudu has organized a goodwill visit to Philippine, district 3820 and initiated our twinning club relationship from there.

The “Five Ringgit Campaign” has involved approaching public for a minimum donation RM 5 per person and postcards will be given to each donor as a token of appreciation.

Total of RM6, 255 were collected from this program and the funds collected will divide into 2 stages to transfer to Rotaract Club of San Pedro, District 3820, RM3000 will be transfer for stage 1 and the remaining amount will transfer after end of the term.

Beneficial to the Community:


The project is an effort to contribute for disaster victims in Philippine. After a few round discussion with our partner club Rotaract Club of San Pedro, they have proposed to us to allocate a portion of funds to purchase educational materials to kids in Cuyab Daycare centre as the typhoon has damaged most of their study materials in which has affected their study. Therefore we decided to transfer the funds as per appendix 1 to help the kids in Cuyab Daycare center for 1st stage, total of 140 kids will be benefit from this project. The 2nd stage of this project will focus on the street child in Philippines which affected by this flood, Rac San Pedro will buy the blanket and clothes to them and arrange them to adopt by the Daycare center. Beside that, we will provide them study materials i.e school bags and stationary for their study. Target of at least 200 victims will benefit from this project.

Original: The 1st cross border project which joint with Rac San Pedro and help a big group of community. We also require the donor to write down some message at the back of the postcard to motivate those victims. The post card will be post to Rac San Pedro and they will distribute to those victim.

Send In formations and proposal to Rotaract Club of Pudu, Malaysia and apply for partnership for the implementation of the program. 4. If the resources will be available: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Purchase the necessary educational materials and uniforms for the children. b. Prepare the educational packs (setting the bag, pencils, erasers, pad papers, crayons, sharpeners plus a set of uniform ready for distributions)
