RAC Subang would like to nominate IPDRR Sanjeev Kumar as the Best Rotaractor.

Sanjeev has been with 3 Rotaract Clubs; starting RAC Bernam Valley and serve as its Chartered International Service Director, President of RAC UTP (after being in the club for only 1 year, and presiding over its largest membership, 81 members, and winning the club's 1<sup>st</sup> District Awards, and being the 1<sup>st</sup> in the club to be a District Officer, Zonal Representative for 2 terms), and is currently in RAC Subang.

What makes Sanjeev stands out is his willingness to take over the position of DRR, when the DRR RY2009/2010 left the position 2 months into the term. In this short period Sanjeev cleaned up the list of clubs from 28 to 20, going against a lot of Rotarians who refuses to close the clubs that has been inactive for years. In his 2 years of DRRship, clubs grew from 20 to 26, and membership grew from 450 to 801.

During the DRRship, resolutions, templates, guidelines, and samples of documents were provided as reference for clubs. District Training Team were formed and used to guide and provide training to clubs that require them.

During his term as DRR, Sanjeev still holds Treasurer and International Service position in club. The task is already a tough job to do in a club that is not very active, but RAC Subang is amongst the top clubs in the district in both years (and still is). Membership also grew during the 2 years and kept growing (from only 6 members when he first joined).

Sanjeev is not only an active member in the district, but also is a prominent Rotaractor regionally (Trainer for D3310 DRA, and D3400 Distas (DRA equivalent), given speeches in numerous clubs overseas and facilitator for APRRC since 2009 and Standing Chair for RY2011/2012), and together with DRR Sunil, are the 1<sup>st</sup> Rotaractors from our district to be facilitators in Rotaract Pre-Convention in the recent RI Convention in Bangkok.

Sanjeev has and is very valuable to RAC Subang. He has never failed to provide the club with good ideas and insights as well as providing suggestions to solutions. He has definitely been a mentor to the members of the club with his vast experience from organizing and executing projects to taking leadership and ownership. His resourcefulness and willingness to help has made both members and guests of the club feel more at home in the club. RAC Subang feels that his work and dedication to both the club and the Rotaract Organization as a whole is admirable and commendable.
