**Part A: Executive Summary**

### **Part C: The Making of...**

Some of the members departed KL at 7am to Batang Kali to initiate the mural wall painting project by checking out the suitable walls in school and started drawing on the wall. Later on, the rest of the Rotaractors came along with the Rotarians from Rotary Club of Bangsar and Rotaractors from Rotaract Club of Methodist College Kuala Lumpur.

The project began with some Rotaractors entertaining the kids with fun activities and divided them into groups to guide them with the mural wall painting project. The other Rotaractors helped out in cleaning up the stores and remove the unwanted furniture which were destroyed by termites.

After about 3-4 hours of rigorous cleaning and painting the wall looking beautiful, we ended the project by also donating some books and stationaries for the use of the students in the school. There was also an exchange of token of appreciation from both sides. Teachers and parents of students from SJK(T) Batang Kali were present during the closing/appreciation ceremony.

The day finally ended at about 1.30pm and we also provided lunch to all the students, teachers and parents who were present.
