RAC Subang would like to nominate Rotaractor Jamie Lioh as the Best Rotaractor.

Jamie came from a Rotary family, and has been exposed to Rotary from a very young age. Although both of her siblings were not Rotaractors, both were President in their Interact Clubs. She participated in International Youth Exchange when she was 15 years old to São Paulo, Brazil for a year. When she graduated from university and started working in Kuala Lumpur, her dad, a Past President of Rotary Club of Tampin recommended her to join Rotaract. As Jamie was busy starting work then, she did not join Rotaract despite timely reminders from his dad. Almost a year later, when Jamie was back home celebrating Chinese New Year, her dad reminded her to join Rotaract. At that time, it was not a suggestion but more like a command to Jamie. Being a good daughter, Jamie emailed the contacts her dad gave her; (then) DRR Sanjeev and PP Kulvinder of RAC Subang.

Thus, began Jamie's journey in Rotaract. Jamie attended her 1st meeting in 10 March 2011. After attending 5 meetings and 2 projects, the club decided to induct Jamie. She formally became a Rotaractor on 26th May 2011, inducted in club meeting by (then) DRR Sanjeev Kumar. She quickly became an active member of the club, not missing any meetings and projects. After a year, she joined the club's Board of Director in RY2012/2013 as International Service Director, and in RY2013/2014 as Secretary. In the incoming RY2014/2015, Jamie will continue as the club's Secretary.

In RY2013/2014, Jamie was also given the trust by DRR Kwong Chiew Ee to be District's PR and Publicity Chair. As the chair, Jamie revamped the district's website to make it more user-friendly and mobile-friendly. She constantly updates the website with latest club events and district news. She also started District Facebook Page and since then, she frequently updates the page with news from district, other clubs in our district and Rotaract and Rotary news from around the world. The Facebook page currently boasts 535 Likes from Rotaractors not only in D3300 but also around the world, especially from our neighbouring districts in Thailand, Indonesia, the Philippines and Singapore.

In RY2014/2015, Jamie will be holding 2 district positions for Incoming DRR Belvinder, as District Trainer and continuing as PR and Publicity Chair. As discussed with Incoming DRR Belvinder, her plan for the incoming term would be:

1. To update district training modules and materials
2. To conduct training for clubs in need / inexperienced
3. To promote district communication channels (Facebook and Website) to clubs and assist them with event promotions
4. To prepare a generic flyer to promote Rotaract which can be used by clubs
5. To organise a Rotaract Awareness campaign at district level

RY2012/2013: Be A Hero Rotary, Rotaract Awareness Facebook Campaign

Objective: To increase awareness of the District Rotary's Billboard on bus stops in Klang Valley Area.

Result: This campaign attracted 40 photo submissions, 1 video submission, over 25 thousand views and 120 shares. This campaign is supported by the Rotary District, Rotaract District, DG Mansoor Saat and the Rotary Clubs of Pantai Valley, Bukit Bintang, Kelana Jaya and Bandar Utama with a total prize value of RM1,200. This campaign was published on Rotary and Rotaract Website as well as DG Newsletter. It was also submitted for Best Rotaract Awareness District Award. Although the club did not win the award, the campaign certainly proved the effectiveness of using social media in promoting Rotaract.

RY2013/2014: Rotaract District 3300 Facebook Page

Objective: To increase Rotaract visibility on social media and use the channel to promote Rotaract activities in District 3300

Result: In a year time, the page grew from 0 to 535 page likes! The page is constantly updated with district news, various clubs' activities and events in district, Rotaract and Rotary news from around the world. As the Page Admin, Jamie took the initiative to join various Rotaract groups to follow the clubs' latest news and assist them in promotion. Her effort in managing and keeping the Facebook Page lively and engaging with the public is certainly seen by many.
