Part A- Executive Summary

Love.Life.Blood Donation Drive was initially proposed by Rotaract Club of Port Klang Centennial and The Art of Living (Klang Division) on the designated date, 5th December 2010. Due to the clash in activity date (5th December 2010), the 2 body had decided to work together in order to generate more traffic instead of competing against each other. In collaboration with 5 other organizations i.e. Ong Clan Selangor & WP (Youth & Women Division), Selangor Kim Mooi Association (Youth & Women Division), The Federation of Malaysia Clan & Guilds Youth Association (Selangor Branch), Ex-Students Association of Chung Hua Independent High School, Klang, and MCA Youth General Pidato Club (Kapar Division).

Part B – Objectives, Organizing Committee

The main objective of this activity is to recruit more blood bags for the National Blood Bank (PDN), and at the same time spreading the propaganda of “1 pint of blood can save 3 lives”. Besides that, Rtr. Gun Chin Yong had also brought in the USANA Health Awareness team to provide free medical checkups for the blood donors.

The final touches before the event starts i.e. equipment check, indemnity form, arrangement of seats and registration booths, etc. were conducted at 8.30am by volunteers from all parties mentioned earlier. Rotaract Club of Port Klang Centennial members, as part of the organizer, were assigned the task of distributing food, beverages and iron-deficiency pills to donors who had just donated their blood.

Rtr. Gun Chin Yong and Rtr. Gary Low were helping the USANA team at Ground floor to provide free medical checkups and offering health consultancy services to blood donors and volunteers. Rtr. Wong Chian Jen and Int. Dorrine from Interact Club of SMJK Kwang Hua, Klang were at 9th floor distributing warm milo and help coordinating with the arrangement of seats of the donors to prevent confusion. Rtr. Aaric Iskandar was appointed the official photographer of the event and was busy taking photos all over the place. All remaining members of Rotaract Club of Port Klang Centennial were helping with the hard-labour works i.e. loading and unloading equipments from PDN’s truck, arranging chairs and tables, etc. on the day before the event day.

The targeted amount of blood bags were 400 packs and we only managed to achieve 385 blood bags, which is satisfactory. Everyone had fun and blood donors are looking forward to another blood donation drive in the next 3 months time, as well as PDN per their requesting phone calls to Rtr. Gun Chin Yong to organize another blood donation drive.
