“ RRI Games”

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PART A: SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT

Rotaract Club of Pudu organized a club service project titled; **Rotary Rotaract Interact Games**, which is usually known as **RRI**. The RRI is held annually between the month of Feb - Mar. The RRI comprised 3 generations, which are the Rotarians, Rotaractors and Interactors. This 3 generations will eventually get together for an outing and so called “family” day, and that’s the reason it is called the RRI.

 - g. Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Dato Lokman
 - h. Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Kuen Cheng
 - i. Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Confucian

Rotary, Rotaract and every Interact Clubs need to send representatives to participate in the RRI event. They will be separated and mixed randomly into 10 groups with the ratio of 11-13 members in a team. The Interactors will be allocated proportionately inside the teams according to their respective school, as they are all from nine (9) different schools.

Prior to this, we used to organize Tele-Matches and once Treasure Hunt but this time around; we are doing something different and where we are deciding to have **Amazing Race** as this year RRI theme.

The Amazing Race is specially designed where there are 6 different stations assigned in Kompleks Belia Akademi, Port Dickson. Just like any other Amazing Race, it needs to get the clues from each station and the fastest to get the clues will be the winner. Each team is required to complete all 6 clues in each station before proceeding to the next station as to create the teamwork spirit. The well- planned clues are as follows:

a) Keep the balls up

Two balls will be provided to the team. The task is to keep both balls up in the air for 5 min. if the ball(s) touches the ground, you will be require to start over again. Team member(s) cannot hold the ball more than 2 seconds.

b) “Scavenger Hunt”

A list of tasks will be given to the team. The team are required to complete ALL tasks and return to the person In charge to proceed to the next station. PIC need to make sure the team have complete and the answer or the question are correct. Time penalty will give if the answers are wrong! (1 answer : 5 min penalty)

c) Wearing Shoe

Members of the team are required to sit on a row of chairs. Then, members are required to crossed your legs and take one of the shoes off. The first member will have to wear the shoe for the next member sitting next to him/her using both feet.

d) Anaconda Plate

Team are required to transfer a total of ‘10’ members from point A to point B by using 8 bricks. Team are not allowed to set foot or any other body parts on the ground

e) Fluid Transfer

Team are divided into 2 and stationed at point A and B. Members from point A will have to find water source by using tools provided. Upon completion, members from point A will transfer water to point B. Aim is to fill a certain amount of water in a pail.

f) FINAL -Hidden Pieces

The final task of the challenge is to locate 4 different ‘materials’ hidden within a selected venue. Upon collecting all 4 and there will be a clue of the key person of the games. Find he/she and stop the time!

- To foster a better relationship and to get to know each other well throughout the fellowship.
- This is the time where the Rotarians, Rotaractors and Interactors are given an opportunity to mingle around and getting to know each other better. As we have mentioned earlier, the RRI is a form of family day where everyone enjoy themselves.
