We had representatives for the positions President, Treasurer, International Service Director and Professional Development director workshops. For the Amazing DRA Race on the 29th. Christine was group leader for Team 10 "Ohana" which came in first. Amanda Lee's Team "One Malaysia" finished second.</p> <p>Two representatives from our club also attended the 81st RI District 3300 Rotary Conference on the 11th of April in Putrajaya.</p>
Involvement in Rotaract Movement in District and/or Regional and/or International Level	<p>In light of the Rohingya Crisis, we organised the 100 Boats Fundraiser. We sold teabags with miniature origami boats for RM10 each, with a note containing key information about the Rohingya crisis as we believe that raising awareness about the situation is just as crucial.</p> <p>A #Pledge10 form was set up for people to order & essentially pledge RM10 to our cause. By Sunday night, just barely over a day of putting up the form, we received more than 80 orders, inspiring us to push for more than 100. We worked together with the Student Council to both pass on the message & efficiently collect the pledges, as time was essential. Rotaractors spent hours folding boats and preparing the tea bags as the number pledged had grown to more than 100. Word of our fundraiser got to parents, friends, and even ex-students from overseas. After merely 5 days of fundraising, we tabulated RM4000 exactly - surpassing our initial goal of RM1000. What started out as the 100 Boats campaign grew to a fundraiser of larger impact than we imagined.</p>

We also combine activities like vegetable painting with essential values like counting or learning colours. We also have a puppet show to teach animal names. Recently we introduced spelling to our puppet shows, aiming for them to spell a new word a week.</p> <p>2) Stepping Stones Tutoring Program The program held weekly consists of an hour of Academics (English, Math & Science), followed by Creative Arts (Arts & crafts, drama). We have received art supplies sponsorships from Grabit.buzz. Each Rotaractor has a fixed group of 2-3 tutees to tutor</p> <p>3) Colors of Africa: Beyond Horizons Colours of Africa: Beyond Horizons, GOLD Beneficiary Dinner was launched to fundraise for Generation of Leaders Discovered (GOLD) in Sub-Saharan Africa, which helps tackle the root issues of youth-risk behaviors.
