## **RY21-22 DRR CITATION FOR ROTARACT DISTRICT 3300**

Fellow Rotaractors,

To that end, go forth to serve and give yourselves the opportunity to feel proud and privileged to be part of this amazing family by earning a **DRR Citation** for your own Rotaract Club this term.

1. This DRR Citation is assessed based on all activities completed by the Clubs between **1 July 2021 to 31 May 2022**, with the exception of RY20-21 Leader’s Camp and District Rotaract Assembly (also known as Digital Rotaract Assembly) virtually held on 22<sup>nd</sup> May and 19<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> June 2021 respectively, in which assessment for this DRR Citation will take into consideration of the Clubs’ participation in the said events.
2. Submission of this DRR Citation must be forwarded to the, District Rotaract Representative Joshua Tang ([drjoshua.d3300@gmail.com](mailto:drjoshua.d3300@gmail.com)) (“**DRR**”) and District Secretary Jayden Gan ([jayden.d3300@gmail.com](mailto:jayden.d3300@gmail.com)) by **31 May 2022**. No exception to the deadline will be granted.
3. To be eligible to receive this DRR Citation, Clubs have to fulfill a minimum of 8 criteria out of 11, as follows:
  - Club achieves a positive member growth of 10% during the term.
  - Club members attend more than half of the District’s Annual Events (RY20-21 Leader’s Camp, RY20-21 District Rotaract Assembly, RY21-22 District Rotaract Conference and RY21-22 District Award Night) AND District Project(s) organized by the District Executive Committee during the term.
  - Club to assist OR host a District Annual Event or District Project(s) on behalf of Rotaract District 3300.
  - Club conducts a joint meeting OR project with its sponsoring Rotary Club AND/OR a Rotary Club AND/OR a Rotaract Club AND/OR an Interact Club.
  - Club conducts a project under the Community Service Avenue.

- Club conducts a project under the Club Service Avenue.
  - Club conducts a project under the International Service Avenue.
  - Club conducts a project under the Professional Development Avenue.
  - Club to actively update its Club's activities / projects / information related to Rotary, Rotaract and/or Interact on the Club's social media account(s).
  - Club conducts a project under Rotary's new Area of Focus – Supporting The Environment.
  - Club conducts a project during World Rotaract Week.
4. Clubs are required to prepare a simple report for each criterion above with justification(s). Clubs are reminded to abide to the Rotary Four-Way Test when preparing the report. DRR reserves the right to enquire further on any activities of the Clubs and to ask for additional proof of activities if such need arises.
5. Decision on the criteria fulfillment awarded under this DRR Citation, upon consultation with DRR and District Rotaract Chair Neeraj Chhabra, is final and conclusive.
6. Please note that Clubs' submission for the DRR Citation is distinctive and **NOT** conditional upon Clubs' qualification for the RY21-22 Rotary Citation for Rotaract Clubs and/or the World Rotaract Week Recognition. RY21-22 DRR Citation will be awarded to the Clubs who fulfill the requirements as stated in this DRR Citation.
