To that end, let us elevate Rotaract to be the pioneer of youth organizations in recognition by our community. Be proud and privileged to be part of this amazing family by earning a **DRR Citation** for your own Rotaract Club this term.

1. This DRR Citation is assessed based on all activities completed by the Clubs between **1 July 2023 to 31 May 2024**, with the exception of RY23-24 District Rotaract Assembly held on 11th June 2023, in which assessment for this DRR Citation will take into consideration of the Club’s participation in the said District Rotaract Assembly.
2. Submission of this DRR Citation must be forwarded to the District Rotaract Representative Ryan Lien Kar Sheng (ryanlienks@gmail.com) (“**DRR**”) and District Secretary Wong Man Ee (wongme2003@gmail.com) by **31 May 2024**. No exception to the deadline will be granted.
3. There will be four (4) different tiers for the DRR Citation and the Clubs have to fulfill a minimum of 4 out of 14 categories to be eligible to receive this DRR Citation. The following shows the tiers for the DRR Citation:
 - a. Silver Tier : Club achieves at least 4 out of 14 categories
 - b. Gold Tier : Club achieves at least 7 out of 14 categories
 - c. Platinum Tier : Club achieves at least 10 out of 14 categories
 - d. Diamond Tier : Club achieves full 14 out of 14 categories

4. 14 Categories of DRR Citation criterias are as follows:-

2	Participation in District Events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club to have at least 15% of its members participate in two (2) out of four (4) District's Annual Events: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - RY2023/24 District Rotaract Assembly - RY2023/24 District Rotaract Conference - RY2023/24 Rotalympics - RY2023/24 District Award Night 	
3	Membership	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club to achieve a positive member growth of 10% during the term. 	
4	Collaboration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club to host a physical project (any 4 avenues of service) with your paired clubs as recommended by the Rotaract District. - Club conducts a joint project with an Interact Club. - Club conducts a joint project with a Rotary Club. 	
5	Prompt Payment of Dues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club pays the RI dues by Jan 2024 as per the invoice received. - Club pays the District Dues by the 2nd District Board Meeting. 	

6	World Rotaract Week	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club conducts a project during World Rotaract Week. 	
7	Club Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club conducts a project under the Club Service Avenue. - Club conducts/participates in a fellowship event involving club(s) from a different state within the District. (Except District Rotaract Conference) 	
8	International Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club conducts a project under the International Service Avenue. - Club signs a sister/twin club OR conducts a project with an existing sister/twin club. 	
9	Professional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club conducts a project under the Professional Development Avenue. - Club collaborates with a Rotary/Rotaract/Interact club in conducting a Professional Development project. 	
10	Community Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club conducts a project under the Community Service Avenue within the 7 Areas of Focus. - Club collaborates with a Rotary/Rotaract/Interact club in conducting a Community Service project. 	
11	Public Image	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club to utilize Brand Center and comply with Rotary's voice and visual identity guidelines. - Club to actively update its Club's activities/projects on the Club's social media account(s). - Club to promote at least five (5) district events on club social media account(s). 	
12	Hosting of District Events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Club host or co-host at least one (1) District event. 	

13	Contribution to Rotary Foundation	- Club to earn a Rotaract Giving Certificate by contributing a total of USD50 to the Rotary Foundation.	
14	Submission of Rotaract District Awards	- Club to submit at least submit ONE (1) submission for District Awards Night. (Excluding DRR Citation)	

5. Clubs are required to prepare a simple report for each criterion above with justification(s). Clubs are reminded to abide by the Four-Way Test when preparing the report. DRR reserves the right to enquire further on any activities of the Clubs and to ask for additional proof of activities if such need arises.
6. The decision on the criteria fulfillment awarded under this DRR Citation, upon consultation with DRR and District Rotaract Chair Yoges, is final and conclusive.
7. Please note that Clubs' submission for the DRR Citation is distinctive and **NOT** conditional upon Clubs' qualification for the RY23-24 Rotary Citation for Rotaract Clubs and/or the World Rotaract Week Recognition. RY23-24 DRR Citation will be awarded to the Clubs who fulfill the requirements as stated in this DRR Citation.
